

KITCHEN MAKEOVER WITHOUT REMODELING -- ON THE CHEAP!

Experts say the one room in your home that pays you back in renovation costs happens to be its busiest -- your kitchen.

But a complete kitchen makeover isn't cheap -- and in this bad economy, it's often unaffordable.

So you should know there are things you can do that will cost you next-to-nothing and yield some high-end results.

On ***The Early Show Saturday Edition***, Taniya Nayak, of HGTV's "Designed to Sell," shared some quick fixes that can save you a bundle:

A few small, easy projects could make a big impact on your kitchen -- all costing you very little.

First is changing/upgrading the faucet.

Next: tiling a back splash yourself using mosaic tile -- which is much easier than 4X4 tiles. Two boards, one partially tiled, the other nearly completed.

Finally, a cabinet upgrade: painting an old-fashioned wood grain a glossy black. Also, adding new stainless steel hardware.

Total cost: \$375
