II. CHARGES AND SPECIFICATIONS

10. CHARGE I: VIOLATION OF THE UCMJ, ARTICLE 81

THE SPECIFICATION: In that Private First Class (E-3) Andrew H. Holmes, U.S. Army, did, at or near Forward Operating Base Ramrod, Afghanistan, between on or about 1 November 2009 and on or about 11 May 2010, conspire with members of Bravo Company, 2d Battalion, 1st Infantry Regiment, 5th Brigade (SBCT), 2d Infantry Division to commit an offense under the Uniform Code of Military Justice, to wit: premeditated murder of Afghan noncombatants, and in order to effect the object of the conspiracy Private First Class (E-3) Andrew H. Holmes and Corporal (E-4) Jeremy N. Morlock did throw a grenade at and shoot with firearms a male of apparent Afghan descent.

CHARGE II: VIOLATION OF THE UCMJ, ARTICLE 118

THE SPECIFICATION: In that Private First Class (E-3) Andrew H. Holmes, U.S. Army, did, at or near Forward Operating Base Ramrod, Afghanistan, between on or about 1 January 2010 and on or about 31 January 2010, with premeditation, murder a male of apparent Afghan descent by means of throwing a grenade at him and shooting him with firearms.

CHARGE III: VIOLATION OF THE UCMJ, ARTICLE 134

THE SPECIFICATION: In that Private First Class (E-3) Andrew H. Holmes, U.S. Army, did, at or near Forward Operating Base Ramrod, Afghanistan, between on or about 1 November 2009 and on or about 11 May 2010, possess a finger bone taken from an Afghan corpse, which conduct was prejudicial to the good order and discipline in the armed forces and was of a nature to bring discredit upon the armed forces.

CHARGE IV: VIOLATION OF THE UCMJ, ARTICLE 92

THE SPECIFICATION: In that Private First Class (E-3) Andrew H. Holmes, U.S. Army, did, at or near Forward Operating Base Ramrod, Afghanistan, between on or about 1 January 2010 and on or about 31 January 2010, violate a lawful general order, to wit: paragraph 2f, CENTCOM General Order No. 1B, dated 13 March 2006, by wrongfully photographing and possessing visual images of human casualties.

CHARGE V: VIOLATION OF THE UCMJ, ARTICLE 112a

THE SPECIFICATION: In that Private First Class (E-3) Andrew H. Holmes, U.S. Army, did, at or near Forward Operating Base Ramrod, Afghanistan, on divers occasions between on or about 1 September 2009 and on or about 11 May 2010, wrongfully use hashish a Schedule I controlled substance while receiving special pay under 37 U.S.C. Section 310.
