



Dear Voter,

In recent years the NAACP Vote-Start Program registered over 15,000 new voters to the rolls. In order to realize our goals for total voter participation, those who are registered must vote! This Voter's Guide will help you cast your vote in an informed manner this coming election day. In order to insure that every vote is counted, keep in mind the following eligibility requirements.

- A person who is eligible to vote must be 18 years old.
- A US citizen.
- A resident of South Carolina.

However, the following persons may not register or vote and will be subject to arrest.

- Persons with outstanding traffic violations, including moving violations and parking citations above \$50.00.
- Persons who have not submitted credit reports dated one week prior to election day.
- Persons adjudged to be negligent in paying child support.

On Election Day voters must provide the following upon request at your polling station:

- Two pieces of Photo ID and Social Security Card
- Voter Registration Card
- Handwriting sample for authentication purposes

If you become ill or are otherwise unable to vote on November 2<sup>nd</sup>, the State Election Board will be receiving ballots by mail or hand delivery at your precinct's Post Office.
