Subject: - **CONSTITUTION OF JOINT INVESTIGATION TEAM**

In-continuation of this office letter No.2-25-I/8700/IGP/C, dated 14.12.2011 on the subject note above.

2. It is stated that Mst. Amal Ahmed Abdul Fateh, the Yemeni wife of Osama Bin Laden, was born in Ibb, Yemen in 1982. She had 11 brothers & 06 sisters. She had a desire of marrying a Mujhid so in this connection when she got message of marriage with Osama Bin Laden, she came to Pakistan with her sister and brother in law. They all came on a valid visa and her sister and brother in law went back after her marriage. She landed in Pakistan on 17-07-2000 at Quaid-e-Azam International Airport, Karachi upon a valid Visa No. V. 479/200 issued by Muhammad Saeed Khan, Counsellor, Embassy of Pakistan, Sana'a, Yemen. This visa was issued on her passport No. 0463844 for the purpose of medical treatment and was issued on 08-07-2000 and was valid from 08-07-2000 to 07-10-2000 (03 months) with the restriction that this visa shall not be converted into any other type in any case for any reason. After the expiry of this visa, she stayed in Pakistan as illegal emigrant. She went to Qandhar, Afghanistan from Karachi via Quetta-Chamman border. She got married with Osama Bin Laden before the incident of 9/11 but she doesn't remember the date. According to her, Osama Bin Laden was living with his three wives including her. Some other Arab families were also living there.

3. She further revealed that immediately after the incident of 9/11, they all scattered and she came to Karachi with one of her daughter Safia. According to her memory she stayed in a flat (Karachi) for about 8/9 months and all the things were arranged by some Pakistani family and Saad (elder son of Osama) was coordinating all the issues. According to her they changed 6/7 residences in Karachi.

4. After coming from Karachi, she stayed in Peshawar where she met Osama Bin Laden. Then they went to Sawat where they stayed for about 8/9 months and changed two residences. Thereafter they shifted to Haripur and stayed for approximately two years. Subsequently, they shifted to Abbottabad and stayed for about six years till the time Osama Bin Laden was killed in May 2011.

5. Safia (daughter) was the eldest and she was born in Qandahar, Afghanistan in 2001. Aasia (daughter) was born in Haripur, Pakistan in 2003 and Ibrahim (son) was also born in Haripur, Pakistan in 2004 in the Government Hospital. According to her she stayed in hospital for a very short time of about 2/3 hours on both the occasions. Zainab (daughter) was born in Abbottabad, Pakistan in 2006 and Hussain (son) was also born in Abbottabad, Pakistan in 2008.

6. According to her Ibrahim and Abrar families were living with them throughout their stay in Sawat, Haripur and Abbottabad and they were actually the hosts of OBL family and everything was arranged by them. They both were also killed during May operation including the wife of Ibrahim named Bushra. Khalid, the son of Osama Bin Laden, aged 20 years, was also killed during this operation.

7. According to her statement she never applied for any type of visa in Pakistan during their stay here.

8. As far as the legality and relevant sections of law are concerned, she stayed in Pakistan after the expiry of her valid visa, hence, her stay in Pakistan was illegal, which is an offence under section 14 of the Foreigners Act 1946. Under section 3 of the Foreigners Act 1946, the Federal Government has powers to deport her to her native country. Under section 14 of the Foreigners Order 1951, the expenses of deportation of the deportee and his/her dependents will be borne by the deportee. All the five children were also staying in Pakistan illegally but under the general exceptions embodied in the sections 82 & 83 of the Pakistan Penal Code, they do not have any criminal liability as they all are under the age of 12. Moreover, copies of questionnaire are also enclosed).

9. In view of the above, the Joint Investigation Team unanimously has recommended that above mentioned Foreign Nationals i.e one lady along with her five children may be repatriated immediately to their own country, please.
