

(CBS) THE EARLY SHOW LIABILITY AND BROADCAST RELEASE AND LICENSE
AGREEMENT

The following shall constitute the Agreement made between the below named individual ("Licensor") and CBS News, A Division of CBS Broadcasting Inc., located at 524 West 57th Street, New York, New York 10019 ("Licensee").

1. Licensor hereby grants to Licensee a non-exclusive license to use still pictures and digital video files and such other materials (including, without limitation, any commentary) as may be submitted by Licensor hereunder (collectively, the "Footage"). Licensor hereby grants to Licensee the right to include the Footage (as provided by Licensor and/or as edited by Licensee) as well as the name, likeness, and voice of the Licensor in all programming (including, without limitation, The Early Show [sometimes herein called the "Program"]) and on the websites produced by Licensee, its affiliates and other entities licensed to distribute programming for Licensee worldwide, in all media now known and hereafter conceived or created, including, without limitation, home video and Internet, and on-air promotion and advertising relating thereto, in perpetuity. Licensee shall have the right (i) to authorize others to reproduce and use in all media, now known or hereafter created throughout the world, in perpetuity, the Footage and all recordings and photographs of the Footage and (ii) to use and authorize the use of Licensor's name, likeness and voice throughout the world in all media, now known or hereafter created, in perpetuity, including use in connection with news, promotion, publicity or advertisements connected with CBS News and/or the Program. Licensee will have the right to edit the Footage in any manner. Licensor acknowledges that it will receive no compensation for the rights it has granted herein.

2. In connection with the Footage, Licensor warrants and represents for the benefit of Licensee that:

a. He or she (i) is 18-years of age or older, (ii) has the right to enter into and perform this Agreement and to grant Licensee all the rights granted herein, and (iii) either owns the Footage or controls the exhibition and distribution rights thereto; and

b. There are no agreements, nor shall Licensor enter into any agreements, which would prevent the fulfillment of this Agreement or impair or conflict with the rights granted hereunder; and

c. The Footage is Licensor's original creation and neither the Footage, nor the production or use of the Footage or any element of the Footage hereunder, will (i) infringe on any copyright, trademark, trade name or patent or (ii) violate any right of privacy or any other right of another person, firm, corporation or other entity; and

d. Licensor represents that he or she has not violated any law, rule, or regulation in connection with the creation or distribution of the Footage.

3. Licensor irrevocably releases CBS Corporation, CBS News, a Division of CBS Broadcasting Inc., and their respective subsidiaries, parents, employees, contractors, agents, assignees, and licensees of each (collectively "CBS") and Sears Roebuck and Company and its subsidiaries, parents, employees, contractors, agents and assignees ("Sears"), from any and all claims, damages, liabilities, costs and expenses arising out of, or resulting from, the submission of the Footage, Licensor's participation in the Program or the use of the Footage, including, without limitation, any privacy and or publicity claims. Licensor agrees that he or she will not make any claims as a result of any of the foregoing.

4. Licensors agree at all times to indemnify, defend and hold harmless CBS (including Licensee) and Sears from any and all claims, damages, liabilities, costs, and expenses, including reasonable legal fees, arising out of the broadcast or other use of the Footage as herein contemplated or arising out of the breach of any agreement or warranty made by Licensor herein.

5. Nothing contained in this Agreement shall be deemed to obligate Licensee to broadcast or use the Footage or Licensor's name.

6. This Agreement and all collaterally related issues shall be governed by New York law. This Agreement contains the entire agreement of the parties, supersedes all prior agreements on this subject matter and cannot be modified orally.
