COUNT ONE

The Grand Jury charges:

1. That between on or about May 24, 1996, and June 1, 1996, in the Western Judicial District of Virginia, within the Shenandoah National Park, a place within the special maritime and territorial jurisdiction of the United States, the defendant, DARRELL DAVID RICE, willfully, deliberately, maliciously, and with premeditation and malice aforethought, did unlawfully kill Julianne Marie Williams, by cutting her throat.

2. All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1111.

COUNT TWO

The Grand Jury charges:

1. That between on or about May 24, 1996, and June 1, 1996, in the Western Judicial District of Virginia, within the Shenandoah National Park, a place within the special maritime and territorial jurisdiction of the United States, the defendant, DARRELL DAVID RICE, willfully, deliberately, maliciously, and with premeditation and malice aforethought, did unlawfully kill Julianne Marie Williams, by cutting her throat.

2. That DARRELL DAVID RICE intentionally selected Julieanne Marie Williams as the object of the offense charged in this Indictment because of the actual or perceived gender or sexual orientation of Julieanne Marie Williams.

3. All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1111; and, United States Sentencing Guideline 3A1.1(a).

COUNT THREE

The Grand Jury charges:

1. That between on or about May 24, 1996, and June 1, 1996, in the Western Judicial District of Virginia, within the Shenandoah National Park, a place within the special maritime and territorial jurisdiction of the United States, the defendant, DARRELL DAVID RICE, willfully, deliberately, maliciously, and with premeditation and malice aforethought, did unlawfully kill Laura "Lollie" S. Winans, by cutting her throat.

2. All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1111.

COUNT FOUR

The Grand Jury charges:

1. That between on or about May 24, 1996, and June 1, 1996, in the Western Judicial District of Virginia, within the Shenandoah National Park, a place within the special maritime and territorial jurisdiction of the United States, the defendant, DARRELL DAVID RICE, willfully, deliberately, maliciously, and with premeditation and malice aforethought, did unlawfully kill Laura "Lollie" S. Winans, by cutting her throat.

2. That DARRELL DAVID RICE intentionally selected Laura "Lollie" S. Winans as the object of the offense charged in this Indictment because of the actual or perceived gender or sexual orientation of Laura "Lollie" S. Winans.

3. All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1111; and, United States Sentencing Guideline 3A1.1(a).
