On Tuesday, 3-11-80, at 9:10^am, I interviewed Betty Klentz W/F 10-27-38 of _____ telephone _____ in regards to the offense. Mrs. Klentz lives in the upper residence of 305 S. Ludington Street and was asked if she heard or observed anything last night or early this morning as the offense occurred during this time. Mrs. Klentz stated that she heard a pulling type sound of a chain or something pulling against the house. She stated that the dog of the McIntyre's was causing a disturbance to the fact that her husband made mention of it to her. She stated the time was about 3:15 A.M. because she checked her grandchild that was staying over night with them and sleeping in the front room of the house. Other than that incident she didn't heard anything else until Lane McIntyre rapped on her door about 7:05 A.M. in the morning telling her his wife was hurt and needed help.
