6. LORI HEFT was reinterviewed on March 14, 1980 by Special Agent Smith and Columbus Police Chief Lee Erdmann at the trailer home of her sister, TAMMY,

The Columbus Police Department had received a phone call from HEFT indicating that she had received a phone call from CURTIS FORBES, that she was scared and that she had moved out of her home and into her sister's trailer. The purpose of the interview was to determine what information HEFT might be able to provide concerning this investigation. HEFT stated substantially as follows:

HEFT indicated that FORBES had called her on the previously afternoon, March 13, 1980, sometime between 2:30 and 4:00PM. She indicated that FORBES had asked her whether or not the police had talked to her and she told him that they had. FORBES asked her what she did tell the police and she said that she had told them that he (FORBES) was there on Tuesday morning, March 11, 1980. He asked her if they asked what time he had been there and she said yes she told the police that he (FORBES) had been there at approximately 1:15AM for approximately five minutes. She indicated that FORBES then asked her whether or not she told anything else to the police and she indicated that she had not.

Chief Erdmann asked HEFT whether or not she was in fear of any harm coming to her from FORBES and HEFT replied that she was not.
