LANE MCINTYRE,

was interviewed at the Columbus Police Department on February 17, 1981, by S/A Smith and Columbus Police Department Assistant Chief Robert Jones. MCINTYRE was re-interviewed for any information that he might be able to provide concerning this investigation. MCINTYRE offered substantially the following information.

MCINTYRE stated that he is planning on marrying CYNTHIA DOWDELL on May 30, 1981. He states that DEBBIE FORBES, nee ATTLESON, introduced him to CINDY, ATTLESON's cousin, approximately one and a half months after MARILYN died. He states that CINDY has "picked him up from being down" and takes good care of his son, CHRISTOPHER. He states that he and CINDY are presently living together. He states that CINDY and DEBBIE no longer get along and are not talking to each other. He indicates that one of the reasons for that is because CINDY hates CURTIS FORBES. He states the reason that she hates FORBES is because DEBBIE has showed CINDY bruises in the past that she has received from CURTIS FORBES including a black eye. MCINTYRE states that he also does not talk with CURTIS FORBES. He states that he does not know what he should feel towards FORBES in that he still believes that FORBES is responsible for his wife's death.

He indicates that he talked with FORBES last summer after FORBES had returned and FORBES told him that he just wanted to get away from it all, that he was afraid the police were going to come out and arrest him. MCINTYRE states that he cannot dismiss the thought that FORBES was involved but that he cannot say positively that FORBES is involved.

MCINTYRE states that he received \$10,000 in insurance money approximately two months after MARILYN died. He said the check was drawn on the Chase Manhattan Bank. He indicated that he paid \$2,500 in funeral expenses, bought his Chevrolet automobile, furnishings for his home, and paid several months rent on his duplex as well as a deposit. He said that plus wedding preparation expenses has depleted the entire \$10,000 and that he has a gas bill coming due and is not sure that he can pay that. He states that he is currently laid off and is receiving \$122 per week unemployment compensation. He states that his fiancée, CINDY, is working only fifteen hours a week at the medical clinic.
